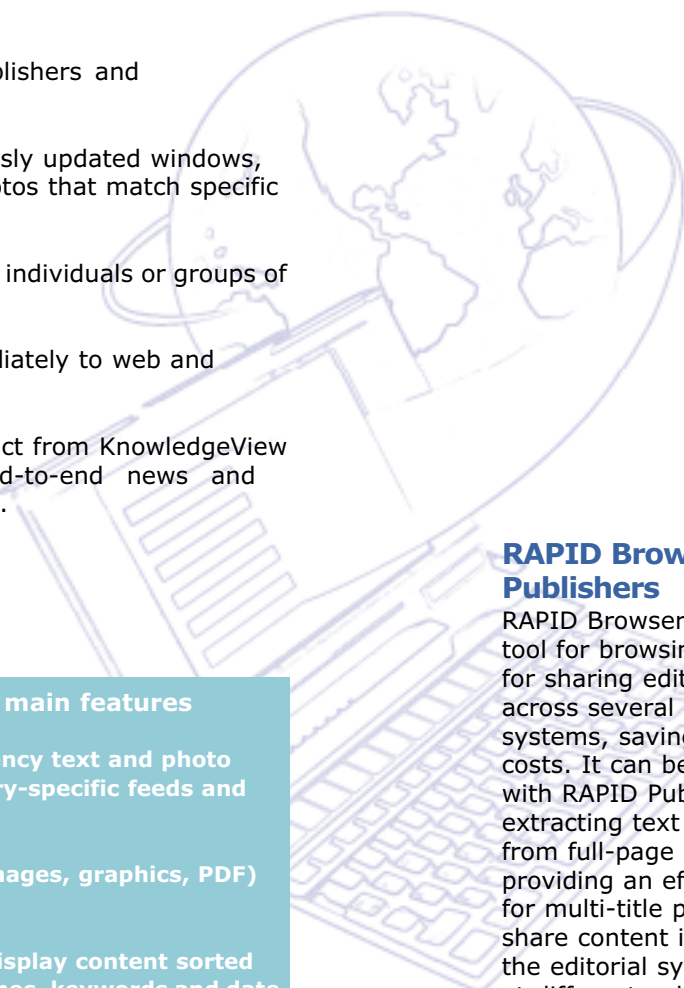

RAPID Browser for Publishers

RAPID Browser is the ideal tool for browsing news and for sharing editorial material across several production systems, saving greatly on costs. It can be combined with RAPID Publish tools for extracting text and images from full-page PDF files, providing an effective way for multi-title publishers to share content irrespective of the editorial systems in use at different publishing units. RAPID Browser can even be used to generate additional revenues by delivering personalised real-time content and news clippings to paying customers.

RAPID Publish has also been integrated with Adobe's InDesign and InCopy, and with InDesign-based editorial systems such as SoftCare's K4, making RAPID Browser an ideal wire handling and content acquisition tool for users of those systems.

Rapid Browser – summary of main features

- Acquire and browse news agency text and photo wires and hundreds of industry-specific feeds and news clippings
- View live news feeds (text, images, graphics, PDF) updated in real-time
- Create customised filters to display content sorted by source, classification schemes, keywords and date
- Apply customised actions to selected items, enabling editors to
 - copy them to individual and group work queues
 - open them for editing in Adobe InCopy, PhotoShop and other editorial applications
 - publish them to web or wireless services
 - email them to colleagues or subscribers
- Create new items and load them into an editorial system
- Integrate with editorial and content management systems, including InDesign-based systems such as SoftCare's K4 Publishing System and broadcasting systems such as Avid iNEWS.



Click on "New" to open a new window or create a new item

Choose what information should be displayed in the item list

Define and update user profile and personal filters, actions and alerts

Select icon to view:
News feed
My items
Group items
Editor items
Web items

Click on the icon to define a new filter, or select an existing filter from the drop-down list.

Click on checkbox to select item. The icon and colour bar identify selected items.

Bookmark indicates interest by the user or a colleague in the workgroup

Click on arrows to navigate quickly among selected items. Click "Clear All" to clear selections.



Play or pause incoming news

Action drop-down list. This one copies selected items to the user's personal workspace.

RAPID Browser provides a way for knowledge enterprises to combine external industry news with internally created information and to share it among employees and with key customers and partners.

The RAPID Publish engine automates gathering information from multiple sources, sorting it and publishing it to services tailored to meet the interests and needs of knowledge consumers. RAPID Browser provides a real-time window to these information collections, making it easy to access information and share it with colleagues and customers, slashing the costs of information dissemination and communication.

Easy publishing and effective communications

RAPID Browser allows you to define a set of actions, to publish information easily and to communicate it effectively to colleagues in the enterprise and the wider community.

Defining filters and alerts to show the information you need

The advanced settings window allows you to define filters for real-time news and photos, specifying the source, classifications, media type, time period, keywords, language or editorial status of the items to be displayed.

Viewing the full text or enlarged image of selected items

Displayed news items can be opened in a text or image editor such as Adobe InCopy or Photoshop, printed, saved to a content management system or file system, or sent to a list of actions defined by you.



Technology used by RAPID Browser

RAPID Browser's Web-based client software can be used on any Windows or Macintosh computer with a standard web browser. The back-end RAPID Browser server, based on the RAPID Publish technology, is a pure Java application that can be installed on any Windows, Linux, Mac OS X or Solaris server and works with any JDBC-compliant database, such as Oracle, MS SQL or MySQL.

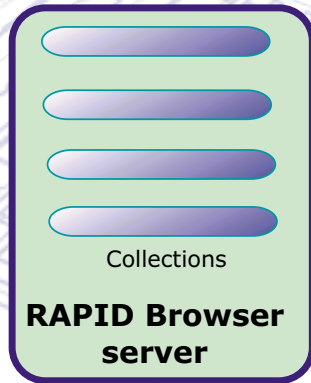
Filters and alerts

News and editorial items are filtered by source and topic and pushed in real time to multiple RAPID Browser windows

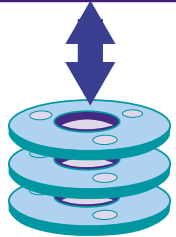
Actions
